The Camino is a self-drive tour of all Churches in the 3 local parishes, with a rare opportunity to find out more about the interesting history and development of faith in the area.

The Camino will start at 12:30 sharp in Carrickmore Church. In each Church along the route a ceremonial candle will be lit to mark WMOF followed by a short talk or prayer. There will be a picnic stop in Pomeroy (bring your own packed lunch and tea/drinks will be provided). The Camino will finish in Donaghmore Church at 6pm.

Food will be provided immediately afterwards in St Joseph's School.
